Reduce Risk by Combining Privileged Access Controls with Enterprise-wide Governance Policies

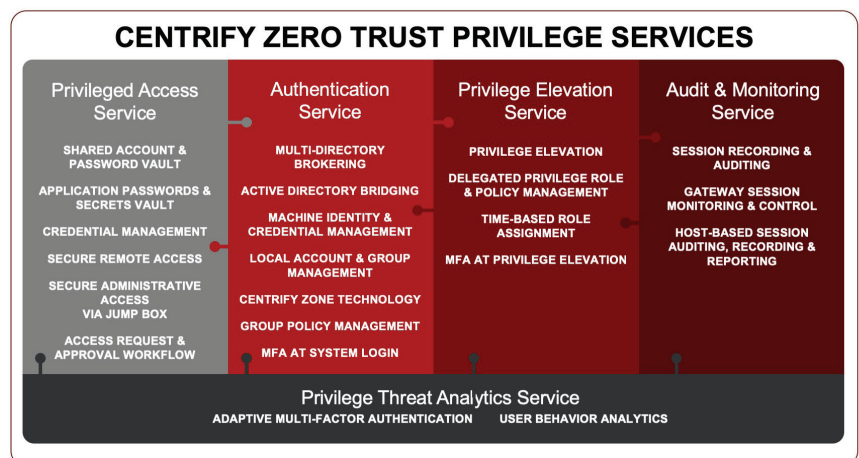
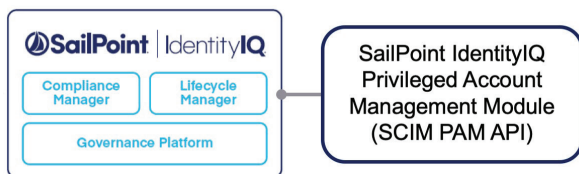

In this context, many organizations have implemented Privileged Access Management (PAM) and Identity Governance solutions in their environment. However, this is often done separately. According to Forrester, privileged user credential misuse makes up 80 percent of today's breaches. Thus, it is essential for organizations to align both identity disciplines to tie privileged user entitlements back to identities managed in the governance system. Only then will administrators be able to enforce certifications of entitlements, ensuring they can meet compliance requirements, and maintain a secure infrastructure.

Organizations continue to struggle with the ability to answer the fundamental questions of 'who has access to what' and 'how that access is being used'. This holds especially true for privileged users. To address this challenge, Centrify has partnered with SailPoint® Technologies to integrate its industry-acclaimed Centrify Privileged Access Service with SailPoint's market-leading identity governance platform. Organizations will now have the necessary transparency to confidently answer those questions, while increasing their operational efficiency.

The Centrify Privileged Access Service is a core component of the Centrify Zero Trust Privilege Services, which allow organizations to minimize the attack surface and control privileged access to the hybrid enterprise with identity assurance, just-in-time and just enough privilege, as well as advanced monitoring.

By integrating Centrify Privileged Access Service with SailPoint IdentityIQ™, joint customers are provided with a unified view into a privileged user's entitlements that are controlled by the Centrify Privileged Access Service. This allows for centralized management and control of identities to quickly identify and mitigate access risks of privileged users, while strengthening an organization's compliance posture.

By leveraging the bi-directional out-of-the-box integration, SailPoint users are now able to manage identity and governance across non-privileged and privileged users alike. This results in higher productivity for their governance and compliance staff, enhanced visibility for audit purposes, and more an overall efficient compliance attestation process.



Centrify's integration with SailPoint IdentityIQ provides the following capabilities to joint customers:

Provision SailPoint IdentityIQ Users to Centrify Roles and Sets

The integration enables SailPoint IdentityIQ administrators to provision users from SailPoint IdentityIQ directly into Centrify Privileged Access Service 'Roles' and grant them permissions on 'Sets'.

Centrify 'Roles' define user rights for operations within Centrify Privileged Access Service, and access rights to resources. Centrify 'Sets' are collections of resources, including systems and accounts.

Furthermore, the integration enables organizations to provision user entitlements and permissions to Centrify Privileged Access Service from within SailPoint IdentityIQ, taking full advantage of the identity governance and administration life cycle tools that SailPoint IdentityIQ provides.

Attestation and Remediation for Centrify Role Membership and Sets Permissions

The integration enables SailPoint IdentityIQ administrators, department managers, and auditors to view the complete list of entitlements within Centrify Privileged Access Service for a given user and integrates the information into the user's certification process (attestation and remediation) within SailPoint IdentityIQ.

The history of a user's entitlements provisioning is available from within SailPoint IdentityIQ. Centrify Privileged Access Service maintains its own separate record of a user's entitlements, which also includes any user entitlements provisioned outside of SailPoint IdentityIQ.
